






Workshop on effective grand writing proposal for faculty



A role play and oral health awareness programme and routine dental check up was organized at Besant Women's college by MCODS, Mangalore.





The CONS-ENDO DAY celebration took place on March 5, 2024, organized by the Department of Conservative Dentistry and Endodontics at MCODS Mangalore


